

# Group to See Flight Work On Carrier

Corpus Christi Naval Air Station will be host to the 27 Dallas businessmen Monday for a show of Naval progress aboard the U.S.S. Antietam, an aircraft carrier.

Along with the Dallas group will be eight businessmen from Fort Worth, who will depart from the Dallas Naval Air Station about 1 p.m. Monday and arrive at the Corpus Christi base some 2½ hours later.
