

YEAR IN JAIL

3 Days Given For Each \$1 In Hot Checks

John Mount Corder, 47, will serve three days in jail for each dollar's worth of hot checks he wrote during 1949, County Criminal Judge Joe B. Brown decided Tuesday.

The judge sentenced Corder to 365 days in jail for passing eight worthless checks totaling \$120.

Actually, the judge gave Corder a year in each of the eight cases, but said Corder could serve all the sentences at the same time.

Asst. Dist. Atty. Clarence Bentley recommended the penalty after Corder admitted writing and passing the checks at various cafes in Dallas.
