

Air Force Group Elects Crutcher

MIAMI BEACH, Florida—Maj. Gen. Harry Crutcher of Dallas was named one of the Air Force Association's regional vice presidents at a business meeting Friday.

Crutcher, assistant vice-president of the Mercantile National Bank and Chief of Staff for Air for the State of Texas Air National Guard, succeeds Hardin Masters of Oklahoma City as Southwest vice-president.

Crutcher entered the service in 1931 after graduating from Southern Methodist University. He was executive officer of Randolph Field in San Antonio during World War II. He has 16 years of active duty and 11 years of National Guard service.
