

Arlington Due Plant

ARLINGTON, Texas. — The United States Chemical Milling Corporation will build a \$1,500,000 plant in the new Texas Industrial Park north of Arlington, Charles H. Lindquist, president, announced. The corporation's 90-acre plant site is south of the Menasco Company plant on State Highway 157.

"Chemical milling is a manufacturing technique of milling metals with chemicals rather than with machine tools," Lindquist explained.

An initial annual payroll of \$500,000 is expected, Arlington observers said.
