

Bad Checks Jail Seven

Worthless check writers had a bad day in County Criminal Court this week.

Four of seven defendants who pleaded guilty before Judge Joe B. Brown drew 90-day jail sentences, and the other three went to jail for shorter terms.

Judge Brown, on the recommendation of Asst. Dist. Atty. Clarence Bentley, assessed the following penalties: Irvin D. Unger, sixty days; Benjamin Franklin Overstreet (two cases) ninety days; Guy Self, ten days; Bill Termin (two cases) ninety days; John William Campbell, thirty days; Edward Brown Jr., ninety days; Leon Tarno (five cases) ninety days.
