

Forger Given Seven Years

Three seven-year maximum sentences for check forgery—to be served concurrently—were given Dennis Thomas Jr., 26, Thursday after he pleaded guilty before Dist. Judge Henry King.

The sentences were recommended by Asst. Dist. Atty. Clarence Bentley. The defendant has been convicted of check forgery twice in the past.

Thomas pleaded guilty to forging a fictitious name on small checks he passed to the Graham Grocery Store, 216 North Bishop; the Wagner Service Station, 1121 Singleton, and the Busby Package Store, 1908 Latimer.
