Rites Planned For Lawyer, R. B. Shults

Funeral services for Richard Shults of 5403 Drane Drive, a Dallas attorney, will be held at 11:30 a.m. Friday in Sparkman's Funeral Chapel, 2115 Ross. Burial will be in Grove Hill Memorial Park.

Mr. Shults, who died here Wednesday, was a partner in the law firm of Shults, Nesbitt and Bentley.

A native of Ennis, he attended school in McKinney and received his B.A. degree from the University of Oklahoma. He was a member of Sigma Nu fraternity and received his law degree from Yale University.

Mr. Shults began his law career in 1926 with the Dallas district attorney's office. Three years later he joined the firm of Flanary, Aldredge and Shults.

Mr. Shults was a member of the Dallas Bar Association, the Brook Hollow Country Club, Dallas Athletic Club, Idlewild Club, and the East Dallas Christian Church and its John G. Slayter Bible Class. He was a 32d degree Mason.

For several years, Mr. Shults served on the Dallas Traffic Commission and the Renegotiation Board under the 8th Service Command in World War II.
