

# U.S. Chemical Gets \$1,500,000 Convair Contract

United States Chemical Milling Corp. announced the receipt of a contract in excess of \$1,500,000 from the Convair Ft. Worth Division of General Dynamics Corp.

Charles H. Lundquist, president of USCM, said that the contract covers the manufacture of chemically milled wing skins for Convair's supersonic B-58 jet bomber and is the largest single contract awarded to date for the manufacture of chemically milled parts.

The B-58 which is now in production for the Air Force at Convair's Ft. Worth plant is rated as the world's first and fastest jet bomber. USCM has been a major supplier to Convair on this program from its inception, Lundquist stated.
